


Dental Nurse Recruitment Evening 14th June 2022

At the start of the session there will be several talks which will cover what it's like to be a trainee dental nurse and what's included in a dental nursing course.


We will talk about the opportunities that will be open to you to progress your career once you have qualified as a Dental Care Professional (DCP) and registered with the General Dental Council (GDC)




Sarah Person – Qualified Dental Nurse, Studying Higher Education
